

## PROPOSITION 65 - Self-Declaration

Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, was enacted in November 1986 and is administered by Cal/EPA's California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA). The proposition protects the state's drinking water sources from being contaminated with naturally occurring or synthetic toxic chemicals known to be dangerous to public health. It therefore aims to reduce or eliminate exposure to these substances.

Three categories of potential exposure are defined:

- Consumer product exposure
- Occupational exposure
- Environmental exposure

KROHNE supplies only non-chemical products which are **intended uniquely for industrial purposes** and therefore KROHNE products are only concerned by occupational exposure.

Based on the risk assessment of our products we hereby declare that no significant risk levels for chemicals specified in the proposition 65 list (OEHAA date 2018-11-23) as being carcinogenic, nor any maximum allowable dose levels for chemicals listed as causing reproductive or developmental harm are exceeded. The above listed products and their packaging materials are safe **under normal conditions of use** as defined in our manuals.
